Follow Hard After Him

"You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear Him and keep His commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him." Deuteronomy 13:4

Did you notice the action words in that verse? Fear... obey...listen...serve...hold fast. At first glance these may seem conquerable, but when we delve deeper, these words are more difficult in action.

- Fear to have a deep reverence for the Lord demands my humility.
- Obey to be able to take His direction means I have to be thoroughly familiar with His commandments.
- Listen to hear His voice requires intimacy in order to know what He sounds like when He speaks.
- Serve to serve Him with wild abandon calls for complete availability to His promoting at any moment.
- Hold fast to cling to Him with my entire self to the depths of my soul means I have to trust His sovereignty.

But we observe, God provided refuge for obstacles and impediments in the way of this arduous pursuit; and therefore the Psalmist says in 63:8, "My soul follows hard after you; your right hand upholds me." (Psalm 63:8)

These words express our need of divine strength, in order that the soul may not merely commence, but also be strengthened to keep up the pursuit. When we insist on relying on our own strength, we soon grow faint and weary. Perhaps after the soul has been going forth in earnest and intense longing after God's manifested presence, there is a continual reviving of God's love and strength in our soul, enabling it to follow hard after him. Thus, "your right hand upholds me." Just in the same way as the Lord strengthened Elijah to run before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel (1 Kings 18:46), a race he could not have performed unless the Lord had girded him with strength, so we can only "run with patience the race that is set before us," and follow hard after the Lord, as he blessedly and imparts strength to our souls.

Did you know?

Firstlight Foundation is in it's eight year in Thailand. It has four branch offices around the country, six paid Thai staff, and four registered projects. Our Mission: Changing lives and transforming communities through Health, Education, Moral, Economic, and Community Development. There are 11 Firstlight Fellowship Churches a part of a network around the country and 70 plus children from fatherless homes being reached Families Without Fathers (FWF).

Ministry News Reaching People

Jesus did it, so can we!

One of the core objectives of Firstlight in Thailand, is to reach people with the good news of Jesus Christ. This is being done through a good number of projects and ministry platforms reflected in our mission statement of changing lives and transforming communities. One of those platforms is Health.

Last months Eye Care Screenings for evangelism has resulted in over 2,000 people being seen by one of the four U.S. eye doctors from His Servants Ministries (HSM), in multiple villages in Khon Kaen, province in the north east of Thailand, in five days! Hundreds were presented with the gospel by a local Thai team trained to preach Christ, and to share the gospel.

We are still working on the numbers of those who came to Christ, as the follow up beings. The formation of a cluster of new believer cells is next. Join us as a new church begins to emerge. The planting phase starts now!

A Work in Progress

I can remember back in the early days as a skilled laborer, in the builders trade in Pittsburgh, during the Renaissance phase in the 80's that all work sites are messy. No joke! Dirt, rocks, mud, building materials everywhere! Overhead cranes, bulldozers, cement mixtures - you name it, it was there! Iron workers, brick layers, plumbers, pipe fitters, electricians, carpenters - all doing their jobs, all at the same time. Concrete being poured. Trucks of building materials being unloaded. All sorts of scaffolds being built. At first glance, one might conclude that all of this activity seems to be bit disorganized. However, quite the opposite is true.

Behind all of those activities, there are plans. Master Plans of how each of these contractors were to do each of their assigned jobs: What needed to be done, how it was to be done, by whom, by when - having deadlines, and what the costs would be. As each of these plans were being implemented, the building started to take shape until one day, often times years later, it was complete. Inside and out these amazing structures that once was just an idea on a piece of paper (blueprints if you will) came into existence.

In the role that I now have as the leader of Firstlight, I often remind myself of those former work sites. That behind all of what we are doing that there is a Master Plan, of what He wants us to accomplish with the resources He provides, to complete those plans. Planting churches, reaching people, caring for orphans, - all of what Firstlight is doing is being carried out according to what we know the Will of God to be. And a lot of that gets translated into the projects and ministries that Firstlight is involved in.

We want to be as Moses who was to build according to the pattern what was shown to him, on the mountain. And like the Apostle Paul who said: "I lay a foundation and another one comes and builds upon it." (I Cor. 3:8-10) As we approach the last 90 days of 2015, we are holding fast the plans and purposes that He has for us. Plans to prosper us, and to give us a future and a hope! (Jer. 29:11)

On A Personal Note



Last month I shared with you that I was going to be having surgery in late August, and here I am a month later, to share that the LORD has done an amazing thing and instead of surgery, my doctors have decided to treat me instead with an aggressive regimen of radiation and some chemo. I am OVERJOYED. A week before the doctor made the decision I had visions during a time of worship at church when I saw the hand of the Lord pushing the hand of the surgeon away from me. Then I saw another vision where the Lord showed me my abdomen, glowing with radioactive light.

When the surgeon called me later to tell me his decision, I leapt with joy. It will be a 7 week treatment with 5- 6 low doses of chemo. I will NOT lose my hair, but will be very tired and need about a month or so after to fully recover. Dan will be traveling to Thailand during the first two weeks of treatment, but will be home for the final 5 weeks, which will entail both external AND internal radiation.
