"No one puts new wine into old wineskins; else the wine burst the skins and both the wine and the skins be lost." Mark 2:22 NIV

Church Planting News: Myanmar

Luke and Jennive Fish are our host couple that is leading this work. Together with a national team of 15 plus coworkers, they are presently caring for 25 children at risk in what we call the Harvest Children's Home. They are

bringing the light of the gospel into over 48 remote villages of the Pulang in northern Myanmar. The reports each month are encouraging. People are coming to Christ as we seek to establish a beachhead for the gospel, as a small cluster of house churches are being formed.

Village evangelism like this is taking place every month throughout the year. I was just with this group earlier in March. We trained close to 60 gospel workers for a 10 day sent out. The plan was that after a week of intense training to spend the next ten days preaching the gospel in small teams of threes, and fours in selected areas - village to village, and house to house to share Christ. Through efforts like these, the Kingdom is advancing!

Thank you for helping to make all of this possible! Your prayers and financial giving each month is helping to reach them. Firstlight project budget for this Myanmar work is \$42,000 a year.

Breakthrough Prayers over Thailand



Last month we stood at several locations in six major cities of Thailand, to pray and to intercede. One of those places happened to be Nakhorn Si Thamarat, in the south where Buddhism first entered Thailand over 700 years ago.

Joanna Perkins Samuels (from Thailand) and Dan Taylor from the U.S. lead this part of the prayer journey to pray over key sights around the city while another team went up to Sukhothai, Thailand's first capital city. The reports from both places were encouraging. We prayed two more days in Bangkok, and then we moved on to Pattaya.

One of the highlights was a 36 hour prayer lock-in held in the city of Pattaya consisting of extended times of worship and prayer, repentance identifications, where hidden things were revealed, prophetic acts performed, future promises received, and prophetic declarations made to set Thailand back on a course of God's intended purpose! Thailand's time is now!

Declaring the Lord's Decree

If there is WRITTEN BY one portion of scripture that has captured my attention for

the time and season that we find ourselves in, it would be Psalms chapter two.

Even though this Psalm was written so many years ago, it would appear that what is being said is a description of our day. And it could be said of many other times in history also - there is nothing new under the sun.

In this chapter the nations and the rulers of the earth are plotting together against the Lord, and against His anointed One, Christ. (v.1-3) They are angry. They plot. They conspire

together. They make worthless plans. And it says that they are saying: "Let us break their chains," they cry, "and free ourselves from slavery to God." NLT

These first three verses are all about man: (the world; the kings of the earth, the rulers of the nations) trying to throw off the Sovereignty of God! Or they are trying to break themselves free from God's authority and ultimately from His eternal Plan. Well, guess what guys: News Flash - It won't work!

The Lord still rules from Heaven, He laughs, He rebukes, and He terrifies them. (v.4) Then at this point in the Psalm it changes slightly. The Lord declares in (v.6) that He has established His King, (at that time David, and then referring to eternal reign of Jesus) from a throne in Jerusalem and that the King

who God has established proclaims the Lord's decree (v.7). And then it says what the Lord's decree is: "The Lord said to me, 'You are my son. Today I have become your Father."

WOW! The Lord's decree is the whole message of the Bible. You are My son, (child) and today I have become your Father. Only two times in the entire New Testament where God spoke audibly from Heaven. The first time was at Jesus's water baptism Luke 3:20,21 (this is My Son, in whom I am well pleased) and Mark 9 (this is My Son, hear ye him) at the Mount of Transfiguration.

This is the message and a decree that is coming out of Heaven today, and then it says in (v.8) 'Only ask!' NLT. It's time to declare the Lord's decree and ASK for the nations as our inheritance.
