A Prosperous Faith

"Beloved, I pray that in all respects you may prosper and be in good health, just as your soul prospers." III John 2 NAS

This blessing was written by the Apostle John to a household of people whom he loved tenderly. It carries such a feeling of affection and blessing. There are those who would say, this was one greeting, sent to an individual or a group of individuals, known to the author, and that it was never intended to become doctrine. However, I would say, that embedded into the heart of this scripture is a simple summation of God's own heart. It reminds me of when Jesus summed up the totality of scripture in 2 commandments: To love God with everything in us, and to love our neighbors as ourselves. This blessing reveals God's wishes toward His children, that we ALL would prosper, not only in our lives, but in our physical bodies.

The proof is in the testimony of Christ, and in the action of a loving God who, without hesitation sent His one and only Son, a part of Himself in every way, to die a shameful and brutal death on behalf of sinful man, in order that we, His children, might receive ALL the inheritance that is ours in Christ. I was training along side of slim, strong, mostly young men and women, trying my best to do the same workout that they were. Each time I walked up to the bar to do a power lift or took the bar onto my shoulders to squat at a greater weight than the day before, I breathed these words: "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Each time, I kid you not.

And do you know? That within 3 months of training in that place, I became the 3rd strongest woman there? At my strongest I was able to dead lift 235 lbs! Nothing short of miraculous, but it was in the doing that my faith in Him was rewarded.

In all promises from the scriptures, it is in the doing, in obedience, that we see the promises come to life. Are we floundering in our finances? Perhaps it is time to make an extraordinary faith gift. Our beloved Bishop Joseph Garlington once said, 'If what you are holding in your hand is not enough to be your harvest, then make it your seed.'

I learned years ago, that our victories over fiery trials begin on the inside, in our hearts. When we can praise God when our hearts are breaking. And God ... is and always has been, a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him by faith.

Counting The Cost!

A special "one time financial gift" this month can help!

the Kingdom in the places where we serve namely in Thailand, and in Southeast Asia. In each location the Lord is bringing about a bountiful harvest of righteousness of souls being reached.

Your prayers and financial giving each month helps to make all of this possible and for that, we are grateful. *Thank you!*

In addition to our core projects and ministry platforms (Families Without Fathers: FWF, Project REAP: Regional Education Assistance Program, The Firstlight Fellowship Church Network - Thailand, Firstlight Foundation, the Pulang Church Planting Projects in northern Myanmar) there are other ministry commitments that are above our current cash flow this month. <u>The needs this month are great.</u>

\$3,000 USD needed for Egypt & Israel this month!: On page three, you can learn more about our going there. We will be serving the prayer needs of prayer ministries that are operating in both locations. Egypt is 99.9% Muslim. This will involve a three-city prayer journey, including a 30 hour prayer lock-in! In each city, will join with the three to five known believers, in each place to pray and to intercede. In Israel, we will serve the prayer needs of

several prayer houses in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem.

\$6,000 USD still needed KAT

India: (Kingdom Advance Training in India.) On page three, you can read more about our going there this month. This will be our second time to India this year. Total costs are \$10,000 (\$8,000 for training +\$2,000 for travel = \$10,000) We have \$4,000 towards the training but we still need another \$4,000 + \$2,000 for travel = \$6,000 needed to make the budget.

KAT India (Kingdom Advance Training India) is a Global Training Platform of Firstlight International.

The project exists to provide advanced leadership and biblical training to national church planters in the nation of India.

I (Dan) will be back in India this month September 7-14 to conduct a second training this year!

The group that we are being connected with in India, is a indigenous church planting movement in the northern part of the country that has been tearing it up for the Gospel, for the past 20 years! Their network consists of 250,000 believers broken down into 29,000 house churches.

Each training costs \$8,000 to train 400 leaders. For September's training we still need \$4,000 training costs + \$2,000 for travel to make budget. A "Special One Time Gift" this month can help!

Last year we had a great prayer team join us in Thailand. Led by Dan Taylor from Arizona, he brought with him an amazing group of prayer warriors from India, Egypt, and the US. The Lord brought tremendous breakthroughs as we prayed!

This year, this same group is meeting up in Egypt and they have asked me (Dan) to join them September 17-22.

From Firstlight we will have myself, Jenna Biernesser as she makes her way to serve with Partners Relief and Development in Iraq, and two others (*Sarah and Isaac*) will make the journey with us. We will serve the prayer needs of several prayer houses in Tel Aviv September 25, Jerusalem September 26-29. Back home October 1st.

This Battle [is] the Lord's!

In second Chronicles chapter twenty, we find the remarkable story of how King

Jehoshaphat, when faced with an overwhelming attack from his enemies (three of the neighboring armies had formed an alliance that out numbered he, and his army) that he turned his attention to seek the Lord. (v.3)

This attack (as severe as it was) caused him to turn from his fears. It says that "Jehoshaphat was afraid and he turned his attention to seek the Lord." (v.3). Although his first reaction was fear, he turned to personal prayer, and sought the Lord.

I suppose that it is possible that this attack may have caused him to seek

the Lord in way that he would not have, if there was no attack!

From a renewed position of personal prayer, (he had to deal with his own fears first) he then leads his people in heart-felt worship, corporate fasting, and corporate prayer (v.4-13). This was a 'rallying cry' for all the people to seek the Lord for his strategy, his guidance, and for his solution. They were not willing to allow themselves to surrender to their fears nor to be defeated by their enemies.

In spite of their perplexities (being out numbered, and with their own confession of not knowing what to do) Jehoshaphat declared: "But our eyes on on you." (v.12)

This then caused an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to come upon one of the worshipers, (v.14) and it released a prophetic word that carried the instruction of the Lord as to how he wanted them to posture themselves before him and before their enemies. His intention was complete victory! You do not need to fight in this battle - for the battle is not yours, this battle is the Lord's. (v.15,17) The next three things are important: 1.)Position yourself, 2.) Stand still and 3.) See the salvation of the Lord. (v.17)

This was not a passive posture but an active position of trusting the Lord and putting their faith in what the prophets have said! (v.20)

The story concludes the Lord caused their enemies to turn on each other and Israel won a mighty victory that day! (v.22) So much was the victory that it took the next three days for Israel to gather up all of the spoil after the battle had been won. (v.25) Beloved, get ready to gather up your spoils!
